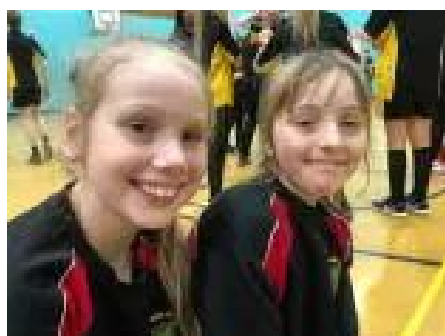
Chinese New Year in F2:
