

## Geography

The children will be creating a new setting for Lego movie and produce a map. They will be learning about landscapes – mountains, rivers, forests, seas. As well as comparing and contrasting Rockingham with key places in our topic.

## History

This term the children will be looking at the timeline of the Viking period and understanding who the Vikings were. This will work alongside the history of animation and the changes to popular film culture.

## Physical Education

Over the course of the term, children will be involved and complete a Viking dance and gymnastics routine inside. They will also work through a series of sessions in tag rugby and participate in a range of outdoor adventurous activities.

## PSHE (Personal, Social and Health Education)

This term we will be focusing on staying safe online. There will also be sessions to focus on how different groups contribute towards our community.

## Literacy

In the Literacy hour, the children will be using a range of fiction and non-fiction material. Our Literacy learning will be linked to our class book 'How To Train Your Dragon' and a range of texts linked to Vikings and animation. There will also be many opportunities to complete sessions with a grammar, punctuation or spelling focus.

## Numeracy

In Numeracy the children will be consolidating their previous knowledge and studying a range of mathematical concepts. Some of these include geometry, fractions and area and perimeter. Many of the activities will link to our projects and topics in school

## Science

The children will be following the topics of Living things and their habitat, animals including Humans. We will study the life cycles of living things including humans. We will also be studying plant reproduction.

## P4C

Children will have many opportunities to communicate and discuss self qualities throughout the term: kindness, perseverance, teamwork and uniqueness. This will be completed using stimulus from our class text and film extracts.

## Computing

During computing sessions, children will create their own stop-start animation based around the theme, 'How to Train your Dragon'. This will be completed using a range of applications and media software. They will also develop skills in data representation, where graphs and charts will be produced.

## Design Technology/ Art

For Design Technology, children will produce a Viking Longboat working through the process of design production. In art, children will focus their learning around dragons – with a closer focus on the scales and eyes. For this, children will use a range of media and textures.

## Music

The children will have the opportunity to learn and perform using the Charanga programme. Children will also have the opportunity to be taught music through a high-quality external provider.

## MFL

We will be looking at hobbies vocabulary. We will recap likes and dislikes (J'aime/Je n'aime pas, J'adore) and future tense comparisons.
